

R 3-23-1 Awards and Scholarships

he Board supports awards for students that are based upon scholarship, outstanding citizenship, service, character, dependability, leadership, attitude, and participation. The Board, however, does not approve of giving awards to students when the basic purpose is obviously commercialism. Awards sponsored by a non-school agency that are recognized nationally and/or that are approved by the principal may be given to students at appropriate ceremonies and times as the Superintendent or the school principal may approve.

It is the policy of the Preston County Board of Education to actively pursue scholarships for any and all eligible students in Preston County. Guidance counselors, teachers, and principals shall assist students to meet the qualifications of the various available scholarships. The board further agrees to cooperate fully with any organization giving scholarships provided that the scholarship applicants are in no way discriminated against because of race, creed, sex, color, or national origin.
